Island Manufacturers' associations on a reciprocal basis, are being asked to have their members supply their own branded booths or product displays based on an agreed template design. These displays will be setup at each destination with a standard template. The display booths, entertainment and refreshment can be sponsored privately or by local government agencies. Interested businesses will also have the opportunity to join the Market Sail display to promote and sell their local products with the goal of fulfulling orders throughout the region.
